### How do I get a Texas Real Estate license?

*It's basically a three-step process. Here's how:*

- 1) You must complete 270 hours of Real Estate Education. 180 Hours of Required classes. (Additional 90 hours needed before your first year renewal, end of 2nd year). These hours are known as SAE, or Salesperson Apprentice Education. You may contact Gepar for SAE courses. ([www.elpasorealtor.com](http://www.elpasorealtor.com))
- 2) Test. You can take the Texas Real Estate License Exam in town, as soon as you complete your core classes and apply for licensure with the Texas Real Estate Commission. (State Exam is proctored by PSI Exams.)
- 3) Find a sponsoring Broker and apply. You can interview as many brokers as you like before you and your broker decide you are the perfect match OR you may apply for an inactive license without a sponsor. There is a State Application Fee for this.
